BUDGET INTRODUCTION

Background Information

The Buckhead Trails II Community Development District is a local special purpose government authorized by Chapter 190, Florida Statutes, as amended. The Community Development District (CDD) is an alternative method for planning, financing, acquiring, operating and maintaining community-wide infrastructure in master planned communities. The CDD also is a mechanism that provides a "solution" to the State's needs for delivery of capital infrastructure to service projected growth without overburdening other governments and their taxpayers. CDDs represent a major advancement in Florida's effort to manage its growth effectively and efficiently. This allows the community to set a higher standard for construction along with providing a long-term solution to the operation and maintenance of community facilities.

The following report represents the District budget for Fiscal Year 2024, which begins on October 1, 2023. The District budget is organized by fund to segregate financial resources and ensure that the segregated resources are used for their intended purpose, and the District has established the following funds.

Facilities of the District

The District's existing facilities include storm-water management (lake and water control structures), wetland preserve areas, street lighting, landscaping, entry signage, entry features, irrigation distribution facilities, recreational center, parks, pool facility, tennis courts and other related public improvements.

Maintenance of the Facilities

In order to maintain the facilities, the District conducts hearings to adopt an operating budget each year. This budget includes a detailed description of the maintenance program along with an estimate of the cost of the program. The funding of the maintenance budget is levied as a non-ad valorem assessment on your property by the District Board of Supervisors.

Consists of attendance at scheduled meetings of the Board of Supervisors, offering advice and consultation on all matters related to the works of the District, such as bids for yearly contracts, operating policy, compliance with regulatory permits, etc.

Auditing Services

The District is required to annually undertake an independent examination of its books, records and accounting procedures. This audit is conducted pursuant to State Law and the Rules of the Auditor General.

Postage, Phone, Fax, Copies

This item refers to the cost of materials and service to produce agendas and conduct day-to-day business of the District.

Public Officials Insurance

The District carries Public Officials Liability in the amount of \$1,000,000.

Legal Advertising

This is required to conduct the official business of the District in accordance with the Sunshine Law and other advertisement requirements as indicated by the Florida Statutes.

Bank Fees

The District operates a checking account for expenditures and receipts.

Dues, Licenses & Fees

The District is required to file with the County and State each year.

Website Administration

This is for maintenance and administration of the Districts official website.

Miscellaneous Fees

To provide for unbudgeted administrative expenses.



RESOLUTION NO. 2023-29

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE BUCKHEAD TRAILS II COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT DECLARING NON-AD VALOREM SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS; INDICATING THE LOCATION, NATURE AND ESTIMATED COST OF THE PUBLIC IMPROVEMENTS WHICH COST IS TO BE DEFRAYED IN WHOLE OR IN PART BY SUCH DEBT ASSESSMENTS; PROVIDING THE PORTION OF THE ESTIMATED COST OF THE PUBLIC IMPROVEMENTS TO BE DEFRAYED IN WHOLE OR IN PART BY SUCH DEBT ASSESSMENTS: PROVIDING THE MANNER IN WHICH SUCH DEBT ASSESSMENTS SHALL BE MADE; PROVIDING WHEN SUCH DEBT ASSESSMENTS SHALL BE MADE; DESIGNATING LANDS UPON WHICH SUCH DEBT ASSESSMENTS SHALL BE LEVIED; PROVIDING FOR AN ASSESSMENT PLAT; AUTHORIZING THE PREPARATION OF A PRELIMINARY ASSESSMENT ROLL; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors (the "Board") of the Buckhead Trails II Community Development District (the "District") has determined to construct and/or acquire certain public improvements (the "Project") set forth in the plans and specifications described in the Report of the District Engineer dated January 17, 2023 (the "Engineer's Report"), incorporated by reference as part of this Resolution and which is available for review at the offices of Inframark, located at 2005 Pan Am Circle, Suite 300, Tampa, Florida 33607 (the "District Office"); and

WHEREAS, the Board finds that it is in the best interest of the District to pay the cost of the Project by imposing, levying, and collecting non-ad valorem spe-cial assessments pursuant to Chapter 190, the Uniform Community Development District Act, Chapter 170, the Supplemental Alternative Method of Making Local and Municipal Improvements, and Chapter 197, Florida Statutes (the "Debt Assess-

WHEREAS, the District is empowered by Chapters 190, 170, and 197, Florida Statutes, to finance, fund, plan, establish, acquire, construct or reconstruct, enlarge or extend, equip, operate, and maintain the Project and to impose, levy, and collect the Debt Assessments; and

WHEREAS, the District hereby determines that benefits will accrue to the property improved, the amount of those benefits, and that the Debt Assessments will be made in proportion to the benefits received as set forth in the Master Assessment Methodology Report dated January 25, 2023, (the "Assessment Report") incorporated by reference as part of this Resolution and on file in the District Office;

WHEREAS, the District hereby determines that the Debt Assessments to be levied will not exceed the benefits to the property improved.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF THE

- The foregoing recitals are hereby incorporated as the findings of fact of the
- The Debt Assessments shall be levied to defray all of the costs of the Project.
- The nature of the Project generally consists of public improvements con-sisting of undergrounding of electrical power, roadways, stormwater ponds, putuble water distribution, sanitary sewer system, recreational amenities, parks, landscaping, and hardscaping, all as described more particularly in the plans and specifications on file at the District Office, which are by specific reference incorporated herein and made part hereof.
- $4. \ \ \,$ The general locations of the Project are as shown on the plans and specifications referred to above.
- As stated in the Engineer's Report, the estimated cost of the Project is ap-proximately \$73,620,000 (hereinafter referred to as the "Estimated Cost").
- 6. As stated in the Assessment Report, the Debt Assessments will defray approximately 888,250,000 of the expenses, which includes the Estimated Cost, plus financing related costs, capitalized interest, a debt service reserve and contingency, all of which may be financed by the District's proposed special assessments. ment bonds, to be issued in one or more series.
- The manner in which the Debt Assessments shall be made is based upon an allocation of the benefits among the parcels or real property benefited by the Project as set forth in the Assessment Report. As provided in further detail in the Assessment Report, the lands within the District are currently undeveloped and unplatted and therefore the Debt Assessments will be levied initially on a per acre basis since the Project benefits all of developable lands within the District. On and after the date benefited lands within the District are specifically platted, the Debt Assessments as to platted lots will be levied in accordance with the Assessment Report, that is, on an equivalent residential unit basis per product type.

 Until such time that all benefited lands within the District are specifically platted,
 the manner by which the Debt Assessments will be imposed on unplatted lands
 shall be on a per acre basis in accordance with the Assessment Report.
- 8. In the event the actual cost of the Project exceeds the Estimated Cost, such excess may be paid by the District from additional assessments or contributions from other entities. No such excess shall be required to be paid from the District's
- The Debt Assessments shall be levied in accordance with the Assessment Report referenced above on all lots and lands, within the District, which are ad-joining and contiguous or bounding and abutting upon the Project or specially benefited thereby and further designated by the assessment plat hereinafter provided for.
- There is on file at the District Office, an assessment plat showing the area to be assessed, with the plans and specifications describing the Project and the Estimated Cost, all of which shall be open to inspection by the public.
- 11. The Chair of the Board has caused the District Manager to prepare a preliminary assessment roll which shows the lots and lands assessed, the amount of benefit to and the assessment against each lot or parcel of land and the number of annual installments into which the assessment is divided. The preliminary assessment roll is part of the Assessment Report which is on file at the District
- 12. In accordance with the Assessment Report and commencing with the year in which the District is obligated to make payment of a portion of the Estimated Cost acquired by the District, the Debt Assessments shall be paid in not more than 30 annual installments payable at the same time and in the same manner as are ad valorem taxes and as prescribed by Chapter 197, Florida Statutes; provided, however, that in the event the uniform method for the collection of non-advalorem assessments is not available to the District in any year, or the District determines not to utilize the provision of Chapter 197, Florida Statutes, the Debt Assessments may be collected as is otherwise permitted by law
